



Meet MI talents – workshop on multiple intelligences and learning techniques

Vienna, Austria, 26-30 January 2015

Are you logical-mathematical? Is it easy for you to write a text or to make a speech? Can you play an instrument or like to sing? Or do you have a good feeling for other people? – Where do you see your own strengths and where are the strengths of the individuals you are working with? – Join our workshop and explore how the Multiple Intelligences according to Howard Gardner can be used to learn about yourself and in working with adult learners.

In detail you will

- explore what the Multiple Intelligences are about and reflect on the impact on adult learning
- gain knowledge and experience on alternative learning methods based on the Multiple Intelligences
- exchange with other participants from different countries and backgrounds the use of Multiple Intelligences
- return home with ideas on how to apply Multiple Intelligences in the own setting

Approach

The workshop will explore how the Multiple Intelligences can be used to support teachers, educators and trainers in adult learning. In order to fully explore the Multiple Intelligences in all their potential we will go out of the seminar room and experience the intelligences in different learning environments (formal and informal etc.). This is based on the principle that multiple intelligence can be best understood by the use and the practice of it.

Each day of the workshop will be dedicated to one or two intelligences, using methods, techniques, materials and surroundings to improve the learning environment for the individual. At the end of each day, both participants and learning facilitators will evaluate the methods and the achievements, individually and together, in order to recommend future activities.
